

Coverage questions?

Here are answers about your HealthSelectSM Medicare Rx (PDP) plan.

HealthSelect Medicare Rx is an Employer Prescription Drug Plan provided by ERS and administered by UnitedHealthcare Insurance Company, a Medicare-approved Part D sponsor.

What do Medicare Part A, B and D plans cover?

Medicare covers drugs in different ways depending on how and where the drug is administered. A Medicare plan that offers Part D (prescription drug) covers drugs listed in your Formulary (Drug List) ordered by your doctor and received through a pharmacy.

Medicare Part A (hospital) only covers drugs received during a hospital stay. Medicare Part B (medical) covers medical services and supplies, like diabetic screenings, blood glucose monitors, test strips and lancets. It also covers drugs given in the physician's office and in an outpatient setting (e.g., chemotherapy).

Certain medications (e.g., vaccines and immunizations) can be covered under either Medicare Part B or D depending on how they are used. The process to figure out how it is covered is called a Coverage Determination. Drugs that need this process have a B/D listed in the Restrictions & Limitations column of your Drug List.



Ask your doctor if your medications require a coverage determination so your prescriptions are filled without delay.

What conditions must a Part D-covered drug meet?

The drug is:

- Available only by prescription.
- Approved by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA).
- Used and sold in the U.S.
- Used for a medically-accepted indication.
- Not covered under Part A or Part B.
- Covered by the Part D formulary or coverage is obtained through the exceptions or appeals process.

Does Part D cover shots and vaccinations?

Yes. Medicare drug plans must include commercially available vaccines (like the shingles vaccine) on their drug formularies (except vaccines that are covered under Part B, like the flu and pneumococcal vaccine).

Are there certain drugs that Part D doesn't cover?

Yes. By law, Part D can't pay for drugs that would be covered under Part A or Part B. Other drugs Part D cannot cover include:

- Drugs when used for weight loss or gain.
- Drugs when used for treatment of sexual or erectile dysfunction, unless such agents are used to treat a condition, other than sexual or erectile dysfunction, for which the agents have been approved by the FDA.
- Drugs when used for relieving cough and cold symptoms.
- Non-prescription drugs.
- Drugs when used for cosmetic purposes or hair growth.
- Drugs when used to promote fertility.
- Prescription vitamins and minerals, except prenatal vitamins and fluoride preparation products.



Your plan includes extra coverage for certain drugs and supplies not covered by Part D. Refer to your additional drug information or formulary.
